Call for Papers and Proposals

Proposals are sought on *any* topic within the area of guitar research, regardless of style or genre. However, the panel would particularly welcome proposals that centre on the work of Phillip Houghton (1954-2017) or Roland Dyens (1955-2016).

The Forum will take place at the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts, 1 Gloucester Road, Wanchai, Hong Kong.

Proposals for papers (20 mins, plus 10 mins discussion), or lecture-recitals (35 mins), or themed panel discussions (60-90 mins) are invited as follows:

- For individual papers and lecture-recitals, please submit an abstract of no more than 250 words. You may also submit a single audio or video file.
- For themed panel discussions, please submit an abstract of no more than 500 words, and a list of participants.

The language of the Forum will be English with simultaneous translation into Chinese.
