WHAT IS IT?

Catastrophe on Campus offers your child a sustained programme of on campus visits and online mentoring to encourage and support them through the first two terms of year 10. The programme also offers the chance for your child to visit other universities in order to build a picture of their possible future options and university choices.

WHAT WILL YOU AND YOUR CHILD DO?

On Saturday 6 October 2018, you and your child will be invited to attend a launch event where you will be introduced to the University, the programme and your child's Student E-Mentor, who will be a University of Surrey student that will be able to support your child throughout the programme.

Your child will then attend additional Saturday sessions at the University which will introduce them to Higher Education, new subjects and skills and provide them with an opportunity for personal development and career guidance. On 15 December 2018 we would then like to invite you to attend alongside your child to celebrate their achievement during the first term of the programme and to showcase the work they've completed so far. During the second term of the programme your child will complete a group project working on researching and developing a debate. You'll be able to see their hard work in action when we invite you back to attend on 23 March 2019 to watch and participate in the debate and as an end of programme celebration and graduation ceremony.
