TOWN CENTRE CAR PARKING

Car parking on the University of Surrey Stag Hill and Manor Park campuses is extremely limited. There are three public pay and display car parks within a short walk of Stag Hill campus, highlighted on this map. Visitors to Manor Park campus, and the Vet School and Health Sciences open days, should catch the free shuttle bus from the train station or Stag Hill piazza to Manor Park campus.

P₁ GUILDFORD PARK CAR PARK, GU2 7NF
This ground level car park is located just beyond the back entrance to the Stag Hill campus. Once you have parked and paid, simply walk towards the Stag Hill campus entrance and you will quickly find an open day information point.
Note: Construction work is taking place in this car park and a temporary road layout is in use.

P₂ FARNHAM ROAD CAR PARK, GU2 7NP
To access this multi-storey car park, turn off Guildford Park Road, close to the back of the train station, and follow the road through the small train station car park and round to the right. Once you have parked and paid, exit the car park on Level 5 and cross the bridge, exiting onto Farnham Road. Turn immediately left and then right at the mini roundabout, on to Guildford Park Road. Walk along the road to the rear of the train station, where you can catch a free shuttle bus to our Stag Hill and Manor Park campuses.

P₃ BEDFORD ROAD CAR PARK, GU1 4SJ
To reach this multi-storey car park you will need to make your way around Guildford's one-way system, exiting onto Onslow Street before turning left into Bedford Road. The entrance to the car park will be on your right. Once you have parked and paid, exit the car park on Level 1, onto Bedford Road. Walk across the bridge close to the Odeon cinema and make your way to the front entrance of the train station, where you can catch the free shuttle bus to Stag Hill and Manor Park campuses.

Alternatively, you can follow the 15-minute walking route to Stag Hill campus. After crossing the bridge, turn right down Walnut Tree Close. Turn left, in front of Jewsons, and cross Yorkies Bridge, over the train line.
