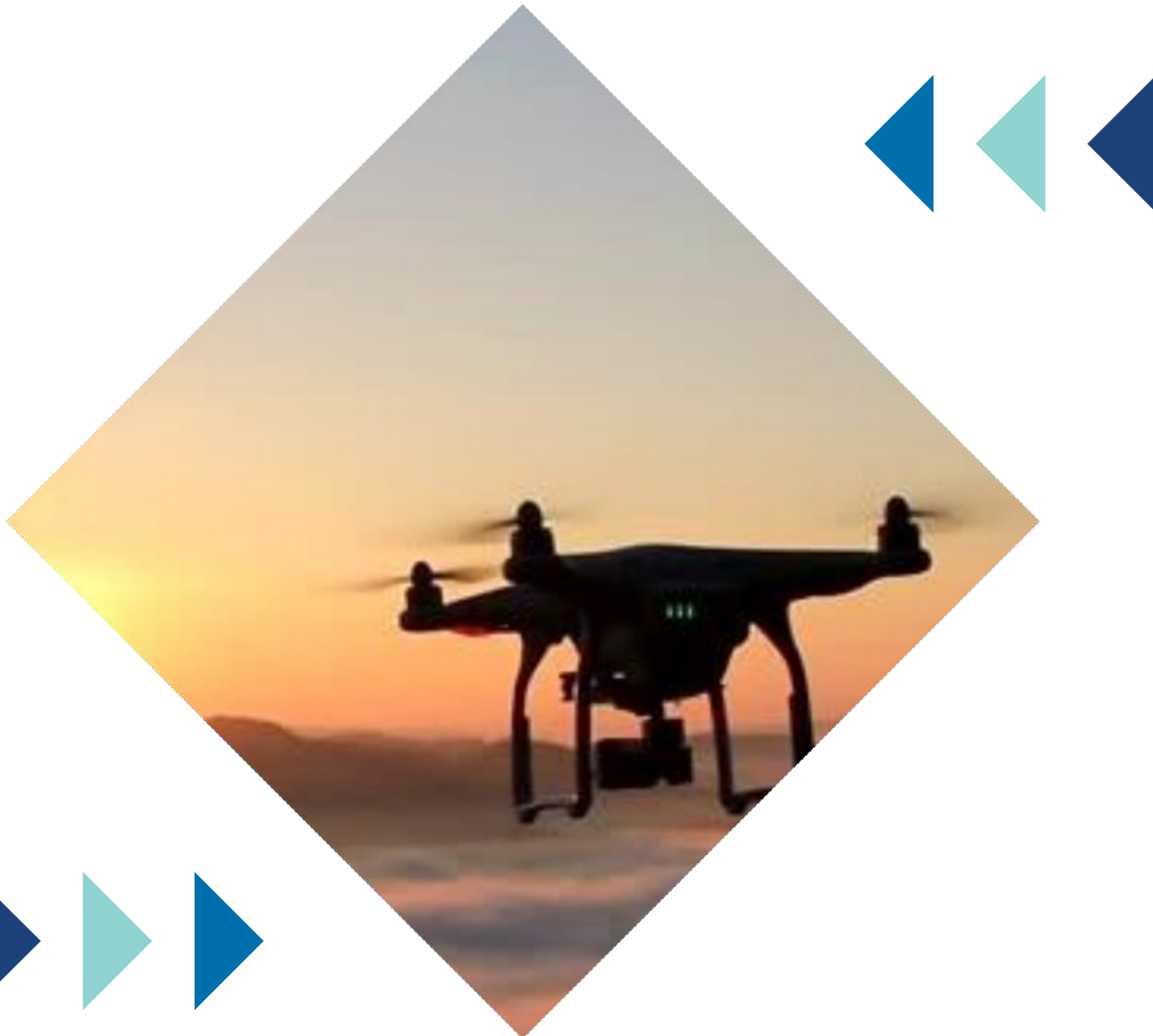
Sample assessment questions:
