CAPACITY BUILDING, STRATEGIES AND METHODOLOGIES FOR PROMOTING EQUALITY POST-BREXIT

This intensive course will introduce you to a complex range of issues and trends underpinning the historical development of gender equality policies in Europe and the impact of Brexit on the equality regime in the UK.

This course will enable you to assess the impact of crisis on gender equality policies in the UK and Europe more widely.

Exploring the gendered nature of crises (economic, security and political), you will focus on the development of key competencies for the assessment of gender equality outcomes.

FEES*:

This five-day training course will provide you with a range of tools and approaches to carry out gender analyses and impact assessments.

You will also study the unintended gender consequences of Brexit in order to examine the complex relationship between national and regional policy making, as well as the importance of mainstreaming gender in the context of international negotiations.
