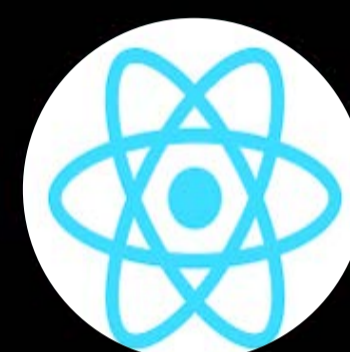


**Moving Forward**

## Analyst, Technology Consulting

Deloitte is a professional services firm that is hired by companies to solve complex business problems. I sat within **Enterprise Applications** where I was an Analyst. I supported with large **digital transformation** projects such as implementing a backend financial system at a FTSE 100 Software Company



## A varied technology stack was used day to day

- Extensive use of **Excel and PowerPoint** for **complex data analysis** and creating deliverables to present information to key client stakeholders.
- Learned and implemented **Oracle Financials Cloud** at a FTSE 100 software company and a multinational insurance company.
- Worked on a solution for predicting parts of an invoice using **machine learning** and created a user interface using JavaScript and React.js

## Digital transformation at a FTSE100 software company

- Assisted in the **successful execution** of a complete digital transformation, from **design** through to **deployment**.
- Biggest **achievement** was taking a complex process flow and simplifying it, improving the run time of the process by **43%** - Saving the client time and money.
- As this was my first project, understanding all the **technical language** and how to manage my time correctly was a real **challenge**.
- Notable skills developed: **communication, problem-solving** and **time-management**.

## Invoice.AI - A solution to manual invoice entry

- Worked on the team that developed the **winning idea** in Deloitte's Global Oracle Innovation Challenge.
- Assisted in the creation and fine tuning of the **machine learning model** used to predict invoice components.
- **Presented** the prototype at Oracle's **largest** trade convention in Europe, Oracle OpenWorld Europe.
- **Developed** a web application using **React.js** to demo the prototype.

## Multinational insurance company Oracle implementation

- I was the **lead design consultant** for the Corporate Card module of the implementation. I liaised with the client to **understand** what requirements they had for the system and then **designed** the system around them.
- The client was **shocked** to hear I was a placement student!
- This was my first time **leading** a piece of work and it really pushed and developed my **leadership, initiative, communication** and **judgement**.

## Redesigned the onboarding process for students

- I worked with a team of placement students and graduates to redesign the recruitment process based on our experience.
