

Digital transformation at a FTSE100 software company

- Assisted in the successful execution of a complete digital transformation, from design through to deployment.
- Biggest achievement was taking a complex process flow and simplying it, improving the run time of the process by 43% – Saving the client time and money.
- As this was my first project, understanding all the technical language and how to manage my time correctly was a real challenge.
