

FAQs for Technical Theatre Arts

BA (Hons) Theatre Production

What is the application process for BA Theatre Production?

To apply for this programme please submit your application via the UCAS website and then you will be invited to an interview.

Is there an audition fee?

There is no audition fee for this course.

How will the online interview be arranged and conducted?

You will be contacted via Surrey self-service regarding your interview.

What should I prepare for the online interview?

There is nothing to prepare for the interview, although this is a good time to ask any questions you have about the course, department or university. You may be asked questions regarding any relevant training, work experience and interests you have, and your career aspirations.

Do I need to provide a portfolio?

A portfolio is not required.

How soon will I find out the result of my interview?

We will aim to update your application with your result within two to three weeks of the interview.

How many students will there be on the course?

In a typical cohort we will have between 23 - 27 students on the course.

How will this degree help my career in the industry?

During your time of study with GSA you will build professional networks and contacts across the theatre industry. You will be taught by world leading academics in a high-quality conservatoire setting. But additionally, not only will your bachelor's degree be accredited by an established and reputable university, this programme is integrated with the ABTT (Association of British Theatre Technicians) Bronze Award (SCQF Level 7) This award is well recognised in the industry as a mark of high quality in technical and production working standards.
