This year, students will be allowed to travel home on staggered departure dates set by universities. Make sure you travel on the right date.



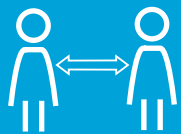
Wear a face covering

You should wash your hands frequently. Some of our stations also have hand sanitiser machines, so you can use these too.
