

## A guide to completing your Grundy Educational Trust application

The Grundy Educational Trust application will need to be completed in one sitting as it cannot be saved. Therefore, follow the instructions below to ensure you are prepared in advance of filling in the form.

The online application form will ask you to provide:

- 1. Your personal details, including the name and ages of any dependants (if applicable).
- 2. Information of your academic history, including:
  - i) Degree/formal qualification attained and grades achieved
  - ii) Schools attended after the age of 14
  - iii) Lower level qualifications achieved (i.e. A-Levels, GCSEs).
- 3. Information on your employment history
- 4. Details of the course you will be undertaking for which you are making an application for funding
- 5. Information on other grants you may have applied for
- 6. Details of your estimated income and expenditure for the forthcoming academic year
- 7. Details of two referees (one should be academic)
- 8. A supporting statement on why you should be considered for an award.

You will also need to submit the following separately, by email

9. A statement from the programme director or future supervisor of the University of Surrey Faculty/School to which you are applying, in support or your award application.
