




How to search SurreySearch for Open access materials

Open access materials can easily be identified within your SurreySearch results. Whenever you see the Open access 'open padlock' symbol in your search results, like this:



It means this journal or book is available Open access, the publication has been made freely available so anyone can benefit from reading and using it.

It is also possible to 'Tweak your results' and to **only see search results that are available Open Access** by using the options to refine your search displayed on the right-hand side of the SurreySearch results screen:



By selecting the 'Open Access' filter (under 'Availability'), this will become an 'Active filter' and your results will be updated to only include OA publications e.g.:
