Values Underpinning Together Project Guidelines



Trust	Trust and honest sharing of information is central to the development of supportive relationships between professionals and parents with learning disabilities.
Open-mindedness	Professionals need to adopt a strengths-based approach and avoid making assumptions and enacting discrimination.
Gentleness	Professionals require a gentleness and compassion as parents with learning disabilities may feel fearful of losing their child.
Enablement	Parents with learning disabilities should be able to exercise the maximum amount of choice and control possible.
Time	Professionals need to allocate sufficient time and space to understand and respond to the needs of parents with learning disabilities.
Humility	Professionals need to listen and learn about the individual needs and experiences of parents with learning disabilities.
Equality	Parents with learning disabilities have equal right to having their needs met by maternity services.
Respect	Parents with learning disabilities should always be treated in an ethical way with respect for their intrinsic dignity.
