Vertical farming in small spaces has started to gain traction in hospitality venues across the UK. At <u>Lakeside</u>, two aeroponic towers stand proudly in the restaurants entrance and have proven to not only be worth their weight in produce, but have also been a fantastic point of interest for our students and guests alike.

So far, <u>Lakeside's</u> two towers have produced copious leaves, plentiful herbs, strawberries, chillies and even Brussel sprouts!

Keen to move towards supplying even more of our restaurant's menu in house, 12 new towers are joining the team in the next few weeks. These towers will be external and will enable us to add a whole host of new items to our growing repertoire, from tomatoes and garlic bulbs to yet more strawberries.

Excitingly, the later will enable us to produce all of the strawberries we need for the University's upcoming Graduation season. Alongside these produce towers, wild towers will be left to flourish, ensuring our local bees are being fed just as well as our diners.

We are extremely proud of our vertical farm and what it has achieved for the restaurant so far. The proof is in the tasting however. We look forwards to seeing them grow from strength to strength and sharing our produce with our guests very soon!
