

Advisory to Indian Students

The University of Surrey have partnered with Flywire, a payment solution provider to remit student payments. The following advisory is intended to guide you through the process of paying your tuition and accommodation fees and to highlight the importance of using Flywire for this purpose.


By following these guidelines and using Flywire for your tuition and accommodation fee payments, you will experience a hassle-free process that ensures your funds reach the university securely and in a timely manner. As the official payment provider, Flywire is the primary method for paying tuition and accommodation fees. We no longer accept direct transfers into the University bank account.

Education Loans: It is advised that student and loan processing institutions (especially Banks and Lending Institutions in India) should use the Flywire “Bank Transfer” method which will give students/parents a local bank account in India (in INR) to transfer funds. Or students/parents can choose to use the direct net banking connection of ICICI and HDFC Bank which is advantageous if students or parents have an account with them.

Option 1

The student and parents to have the loan processing institution transfer funds into the bank account of the student or parent (or co-borrower), rather than making payment to Flywire to facilitate the process. Here is the further overview of steps to be followed

1. Indian Banks/Lending Institutions need to transfer funds into the bank account of the student/parent/co-borrower
2. Student/parent/co-borrower to complete a booking on Flywire portal [Surrey Flywire Payments](#) and complete the payment either by bank transfer method (funds to be transferred in the INR), bank account displayed in the payment instruction (transfer to be done in INR) or by completing the payment on ICICI and HDFC net banking method in case the payer has an account with ICICI or HDFC Bank. In all these 3 methods the Bank/ Lending Institutions need to transfer the funds into the bank of the student/parent/co-borrower for them to further transfer the INR to Flywire
3. In all the 3 above cases, the Indian Bank/Lending Institution must disburse the INR equivalent of the GBP which the student is required to pay
4. In all cases (irrespective of loan or own funds), Flywire provides confirmation to the sender (student, parent, co-borrower) of the delivery of the funds to the university. The Bank or Lending Institution can request from the sender (Student) a copy of this confirmation for their records for ‘usage of funds’ purposes.

Note

Flywire holds the exchange rate for the period stated on the letter to allow time for payment to be made from the Institution to the individual and on to the University.

Option 2

The loan processing institution transfers funds directly to the University via Flywire. A letter can be generated from the Flywire payment portal to provide the payment details and reference for the Bank or Lending Institution.

1. The student needs to log onto the Flywire portal using their student number and details.
2. The Payment details can be generated from the Flywire payment portal once the student has logged in and selected to pay through the “bank transfer” method. You can print or email this confirmation once you have completed up to and including section 5 “Review & Confirm”.
3. This confirmation provides your Bank/Lending Institution with the payment details and unique transaction reference for the student to pay the University the fees owed including:-
 - A. Amount in GBP (Sterling)
 - B. Time frame to complete the transaction
 - C. Unique Payment Reference to make payment directly to the University.
 - D. Link for your Bank/Lender to access Flywire to complete the payment
4. This can be provided to any Bank or Lending Institution
5. Once the payment has been received, Flywire will confirm the delivery of the funds to the University. The Bank / Lending Institution can seek from the sender (Student) a copy of the confirmation for records for ‘usage of funds’ purposes.

6. If you are unable to initiate your transfer by the due date, cancel your payment request and create a new one closer to a date when you expect to be able to complete your transfer and provide the funder with an updated letter. Please note that there may be fluctuations in exchange rate should you choose to cancel your original booking. You may be able to request an extension of your due date only if you chose to pay with an international bank transfer in your institution's currency. To request an extension for this type of payment, contact the dedicated Flywire Support team on the link below.
