Clearing 2024 Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

By entering the Clearing 2024 prize draw ("**Prize Draw**"), entrants confirm that they have read and agree to be bound by these terms and conditions. If an entrant is under the age of 18, the entrant confirms that their parent/guardian agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions.

1. The Prize Draw is held by the University of Surrey, Guildford, Surrey, GU2 7XH (the "University").

The University's decision will be final, and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.

- 10. The winner will be notified via email during the week commencing 2 September 2024. The winner must provide their email address or postal address to the University to receive their prize.
- 11. The winners will also be announced on the University's digital platforms.
- 12. The prize will be 1 Hydroponics Growing System including herb seeds and pods. The University reserves the right to replace the prize with an alternative prize of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond the University's reasonable control make it necessary to do so. This will be sent/posted within 14 working days of notification.
- 13. The prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered.
- 14. Personal data supplied for the Prize Draw will only be processed as set out in the <u>University's Privacy Notice</u>. For children under 18 years old, consent from a person holding parental responsibility is required. By entering, entrants agree that any personal information provided with their entry may be held and used by the University or its agents and suppliers to administer the Prize Draw.
