OPEN DAY PARKING

WHEN YOU ARRIVE


When you arrive, follow signs to the check-in point on the Piazza on Stag Hill campus, where we will scan your ticket.

FREE SHUTTLE BUS

From 8am to 4:30pm, our free open day shuttle buses run between Guildford train station, Stag Hill campus and Manor Park campus approximately every **15 minutes.**
