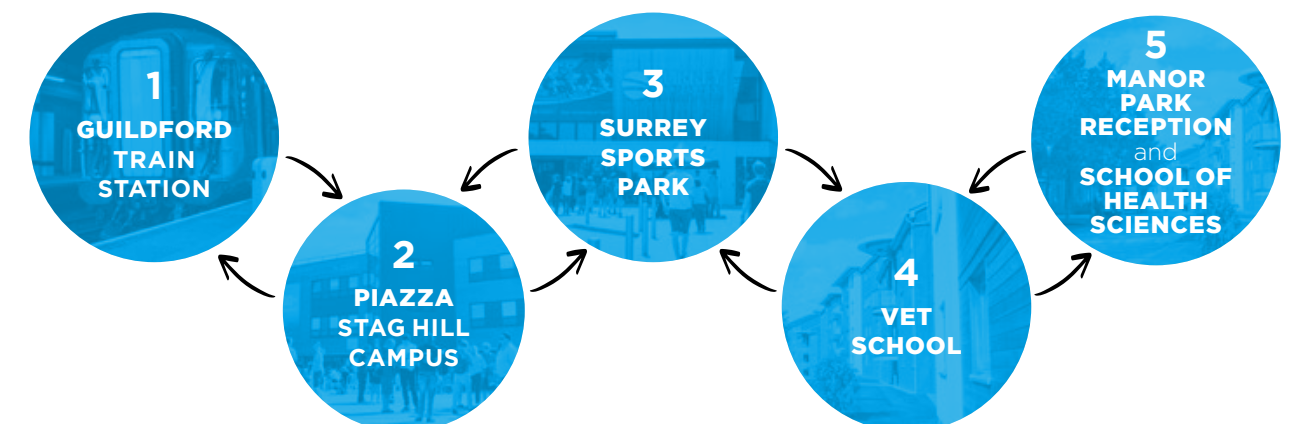
GETTING AROUND

If you are driving, parking on campus is limited. Once our car parks are full, you will be directed off campus to pay and display car parks, a short walk from campus.

When you arrive, follow signs to the check-in point on the Piazza on Stag Hill campus, where we will scan your ticket.

If you have any accessibility requirements, please visit our Information and Accessibility Point next to check-in. Here, staff and students can offer advice to make sure you get the most out of your day.

From 8am to 4:30pm, our free open day shuttle buses run between Guildford train station, Stag Hill campus and Manor Park campus approximately every **15 minutes**.



JOIN A TOUR

Explore our beautiful green campus during your open day to get a feel for what it could be like to live and study here.

STAG HILL CAMPUS TOURS

Student ambassadors will lead you around the grounds and facilities on our Stag Hill campus.

To join a tour, go to the meeting point on the Piazza.

Tours run every 15 minutes from 9am and last approximately 50 minutes. The last tour leaves at 3pm.

SURREY SPORTS PARK TOURS

Explore our amazing sports facilities at Surrey Sports Park and hear our students' sport experiences. Tours start at Surrey Sports Park on our Manor Park campus.

Tours last 30 minutes, and leave every half hour between 10am and 3pm.

Also, come along to the World Cup Suite at Surrey Sports Park to learn more about our world-class Performance Sport programme.

Talks take place at 11:30am and 1pm.

This programme is designed to maximise the potential of both individual and team performance of our talented and hard working student athletes.

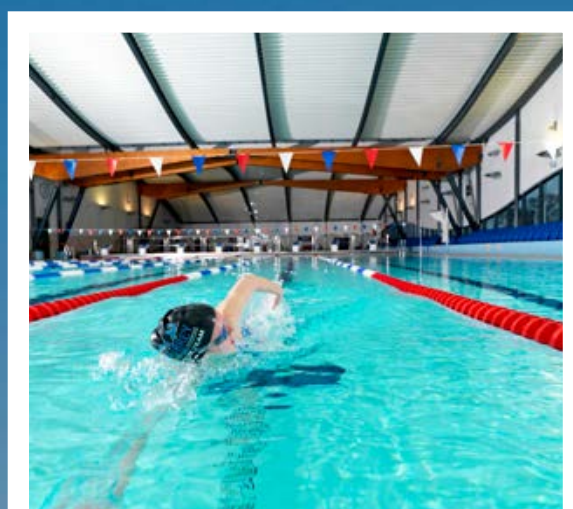
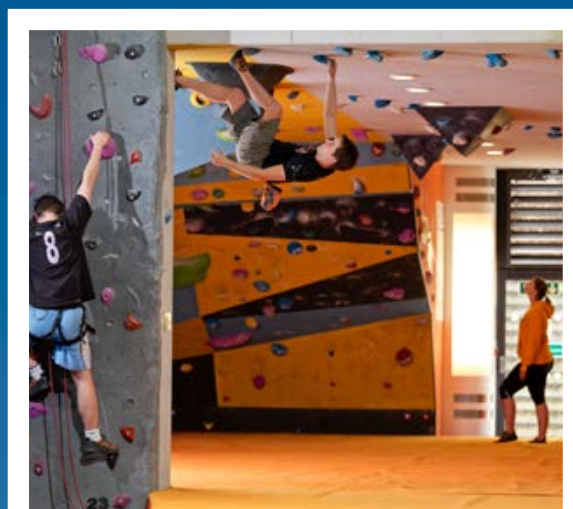


Team Surrey's Performance Sport Programme is designed to maximise the potential of both individual and team performance of our talented and hard-working student athletes.

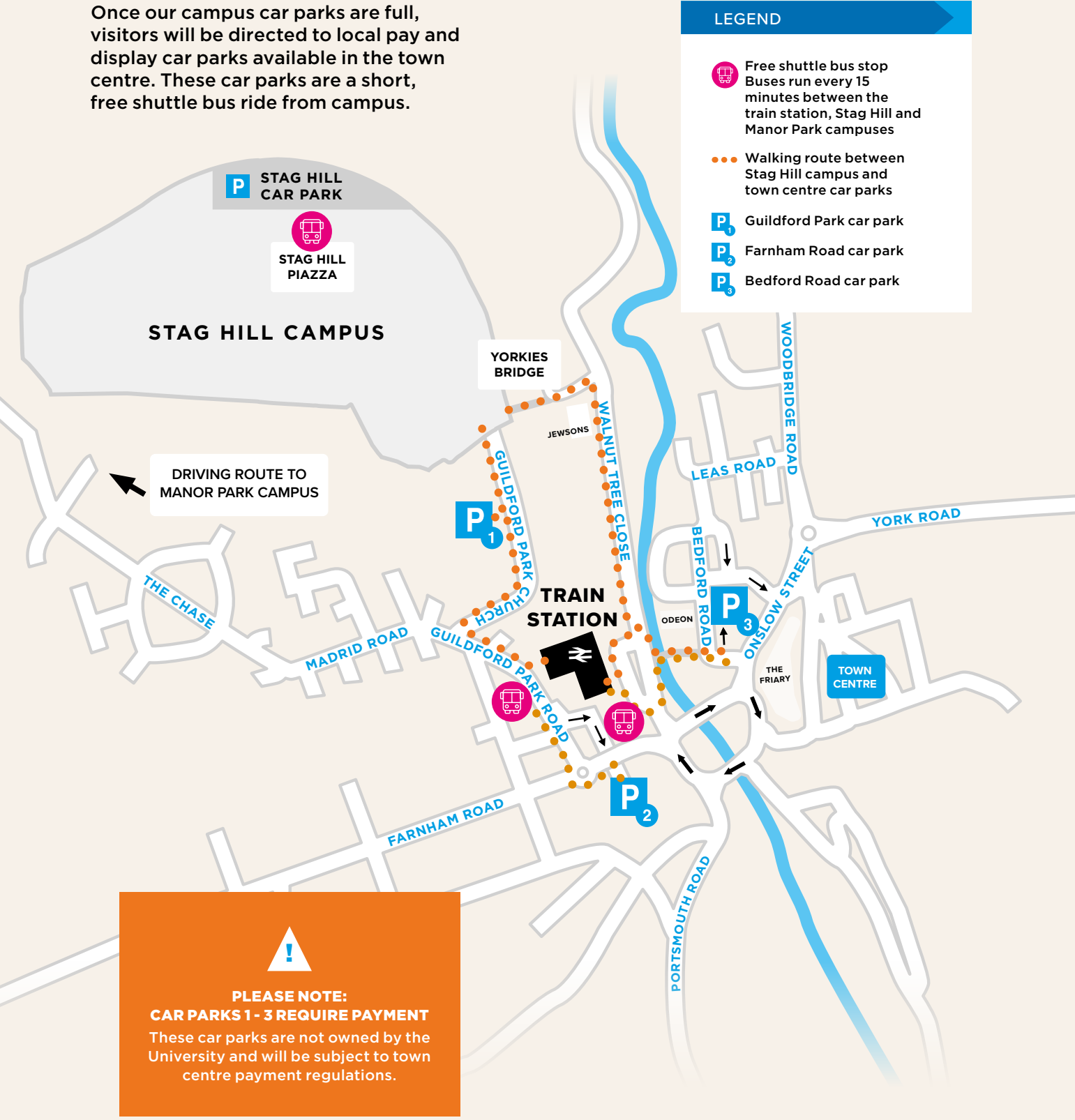
