GUEST SPEAKER

OLGA FITZROY – CEREMONY C

Award-winning recording and mixing engineer Olga FitzRoy graduated from the University of Surrey's Tonmeister course in 2005. Following a professional placement year at Sir George Martin's AIR Studios, she worked there for a decade upon graduating, with artists including Foo Fighters, Seasick Steve, and Hans Zimmer.

Now freelance, she has worked on TV scores such as The Crown with Martin Phipps, Doctor Who with Segun Akinola, and films Living, and Napoleon. Alongside her film and TV work, she has engineered for some of the world's biggest acts including Coldplay, Tony Christie, and Dua Lipa.

Olga is a prominent advocate on women's issues, with her campaign for Parental Pay Equality resulting in a new bill being debated in Parliament, and leading legal action on behalf of the charity Pregnant Then Screwed against the chancellor for discriminating against self-employed mothers during Covid.

As a board member of UK Music and the Music Producers Guild (2019-2022) she was instrumental in securing government support for recording studios to reopen safely after the pandemic, saving thousands of jobs in the industry.

She is also a Labour and co-operative councillor in Lambeth, where she lives with her husband and son.



GUEST SPEAKER

ADELE PARKS, MBE – CEREMONY D

Dr Adele Parks MBE was born in North Yorkshire. She is the author of 23 bestselling novels including the Sunday Times bestsellers *Just Between Us* and *Both Of You*. 5 million UK editions of her work have been sold and her books have been translated into 31 different languages.

Adele's Sunday Times Number One bestsellers, *Lies Lies Lies* and *Just My Luck*, were shortlisted for the British Book Awards and have been optioned for development for TV. Her novel, *The Image of You* is due to be released as a major motion picture by Paramount this year. Adele was an Executive Producer on the film.

Besides novel writing, Adele has written articles for many national newspapers and magazines and numerous short stories. Her first anthology of short stories was published in 2017. She is a proud, long-term ambassador of the National Literacy Trust and the Reading Agency: two charities that promote literacy in the UK. Adele often appears on TV and radio to discuss matters relating to literacy and the publishing industry. She has lived in Botswana, Italy and London and, since 2005, has been settled in Guildford, Surrey.

In 2022 she was awarded an MBE for services to literature.

NARVIR BRARD – CEREMONY E

Narvir graduated from the University of Surrey in 1997 with a BSc in Business Economics. He began his career in finance on the Citigroup graduate scheme, before going on to hold senior positions at Nomura, J.P.Morgan and BNP Paribas.

Narvir is currently based in London as a Managing Director at Bank of America Merrill Lynch, with responsibility for UK Equity Derivative Sales.

He is a co-founder of the University of Surrey O'Neill-Brard Scholarship, which each year funds one Economics undergraduate student for their three years of study.

MEGAN GOODWIN – CEREMONY F

Megan is a member of Surrey Business School's Advisory Board. A content innovator and digital media entrepreneur with a successful history in deal negotiation and a talent for developing long-term business partnerships, Megan has been digital strategy advisory to some of the most notable international media companies including Endemol, Star Television, BBC Worldwide and Fox Television advising on some of the world's best-known TV series.

Megan started out in marketing and business development for the entrepreneurial internet businesses at News International and later Express Newspapers at the beginning of the digital revolution. As a result, Megan

was headhunted by Celador International to spearhead the digital development of the show 'Who Wants to Be a Millionaire', which went on to win 10 awards and went live in 60 countries. After 4 years Megan raised seed funding and set up a digital innovation business called IRM that works with some of the world's biggest brands, including Agatha Christie, Dancing with the Stars, Big Brother and Total Wipeout.

More recently, as a result of the pandemic and the video meeting boom, Megan has launched 'the vision' which provides a series of online sessions with a "pop up" advisory board of three world-class diverse digital experts selected to unlock business challenges.







A LITTLE HISTORY

NEARLY 60 YEARS OF SURREY DEGREES

The University of Surrey was established on 9 September 1966 with the grant of its Royal Charter, but its roots go back to 1891, when its forerunner Battersea Polytechnic Institute was founded to teach poorer London inhabitants. As its academic reputation grew, the renamed Battersea College of Technology moved to Guildford in the 1960s, where it became a university awarding its own degrees.

Since July 1970, by kind permission of the Dean and Chapter, degree conferment ceremonies have been held in Guildford Cathedral. On these occasions it is used as a secular building.

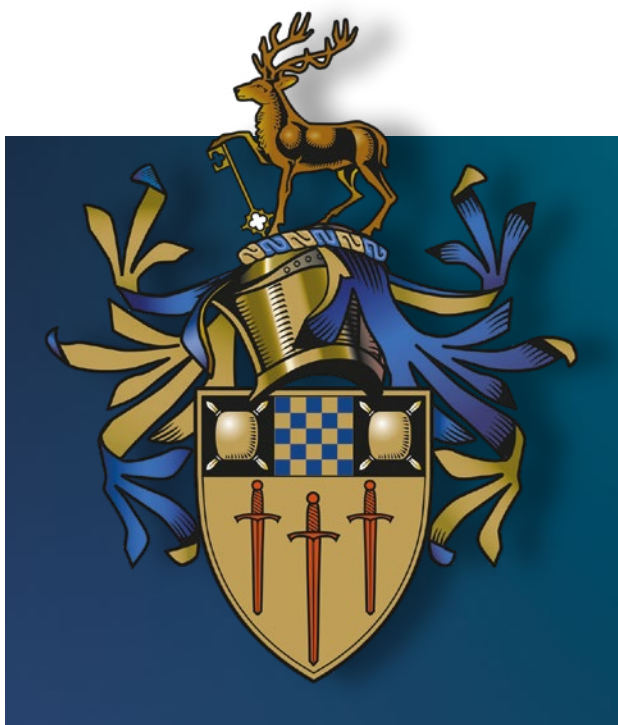


The mace

The University mace was designed and crafted by Desmond Clen Murphy and used ceremonially for the first time at the Installation as Chancellor of the Rt Hon the Lord Robens of Woldingham in 1966.

The mace is made of silver and walnut wood, with the shield of the University coat of arms on its head in colour, and with the shields of the coat of arms of Surrey County Council, Guildford Borough Council and Battersea Polytechnic Institute engraved in silver underneath. The embroidered coat of arms on the mace table, carried out in metallic thread, French knots, applied leathers and various materials, was created by Christine Habib, a former student of the Hampton School of Embroidery.

The mace was presented to Guildford Cathedral for permanent display on 13 July 1997.



The arms of the University of Surrey

The University of Surrey coat of arms commemorates the University's move from London to Guildford. The woolpacks on the shield are taken from the arms of the Borough of Guildford, while the blue and gold chequers and mantling are from the arms of the former Earls of Surrey. The swords, an allusion to the arms of the City of London, are taken from the shield of Battersea Polytechnic.

The blazon of the University's coat of arms, which was granted in 1966, is topped by a stag resting its right leg on an upturned key. The stag denotes the medieval royal hunting park on which our leafy Stag Hill site has been developed, while the key is a heraldic symbol of learning.

The coat of arms is an elegant symbol of our reputation and standing.

ACADEMIC DRESS

Every university has a distinctive set of academic robes for the degrees it awards and special ceremonial robes for the high officers of the university. The blue brocade that features in the hoods of all our robes is unique to Surrey and distinguishes us from other universities.

GRADUATE ROBES

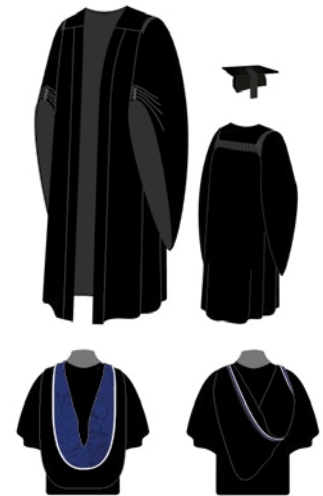
Undergraduate and masters degrees

Graduates wear a black gown and a black cloth mortar board. Hoods are usually fully lined with blue brocade and vary in design depending on whether the award is undergraduate or postgraduate.



Diploma and certificate awards

Diplomates wear a black gown and a black cloth mortar board. Postgraduate hoods are fully lined with blue brocade, with a plain white trim. Undergraduate hoods have a blue brocade and plain white trim.



Doctorate awards

Gowns are in cardinal red with blue brocade on the front facings. The hoods are cardinal red, fully lined with University brocade and have a ribbon trim rebated from the outside edge of the hood. The hat is a black cloth bonnet with red cord and tassels, with the exception of Doctors of Letters, Science and Medicine where the cord and tassels are gold.

The colour of the trim on the hoods denotes the type of degree:

Bachelor and Master of Arts, Doctor of Letters - Red ribbon

Bachelor, Master and Doctor of Education - Green ribbon

Bachelor, Master and Doctor of Engineering - Grey ribbon

Bachelor and Master of Laws - Purple ribbon

Bachelor and Master of Music - White brocade

Bachelor, Master and Doctor of Science - No trim

Bachelor of Veterinary Medicine - Pale yellow ribbon

Master of Business - Ruby ribbon

Master of Chemistry / of Computing / of Mathematics / in Physics / in Science (MSci) - Pale blue ribbon
