

Maternity leave policy: Neonatal leave



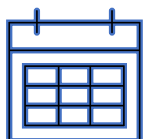
What's new? The University has updated its maternity leave policy to include neonatal leave.



What is neonatal leave? Neonatal Leave is a day one right for employees whose baby has been born prematurely and is hospitalised.



Who's eligible? Employees who are entitled to maternity leave, will also be entitled to an additional period of leave to add to the end of their maternity leave or shared parental leave if their baby is in hospital for at least 7 consecutive days in the first four weeks of the child's life



How many weeks is the additional leave? The University will pay up to 12 weeks additional pay for neonatal care, which must be taken within 68 weeks of the child's life.
