2.	PP2250582 4-Year Review	
	PPL holder gave verbal summary of the work. The purpose of this PPL is to support the development of new and improved vaccines, with a focus on developing platforms amenable to several diseases. This licence has taken place on two different sites. The PIL holder explained that there was no duplication of work.	
	It was mentioned that using aged mice was a challenge due to cost and low availability. The PIL holder was informed about the tissue sharing program at Surrey and has already provided bone marrow from aged mice to another researcher at the institution. They intend to remain in contact with other researchers for potential future sharing. After encountering technical difficulties with the tail bleed procedure using the blade method, it was switched to the syringe technique. However, this method remains challenging. NVS provided guidance on improving the procedure, and the adjustment was considered a refinement.  The Chair thanked the PPL for providing their report and	
	the committee indicated they were satisfied with the progress being made on the PPL including activities related to the 3Rs.
