Instructions for teachers

What do I need before I begin?

- This document, containing the assessment instructions
- A geometry assessment booklet for every child in the class
- A pencil/pen for every child in the class

What will I have to do for the assessment?

- Read aloud the text that is italicised
- The test is estimated to take approximately 15 minutes. Please stop the children and collect the test after 15 minutes, even if some children have not got to the end of the assessment.

Set Up.

- When the children are all sat down, give them the geometry assessment booklet.
- Ask the children to write their name in pencil on the front of the booklet.
- Ensure the children do not look at the questions until the rest of the class is ready. Children should work on their own.

Today you're going to be doing a shapes quiz. This is a quiz that is given to older children too, so don't worry if some of the questions are too hard for you, just have a go at as much as you can and if a question is too hard, go on to the next question. There is no pass mark on this quiz. When you're done, sit quietly until I tell you the quiz is over. Don't worry if you don't get to the end. Don't open your booklets until you're told to. Are there any questions?

When you're finished, please sit quietly (and read a book [or whatever is normal for children in your school in this kind of situation] until I collect your quiz. You can start now.

[Wait until approximately 15 minutes have elapsed and collect all assessment booklets].
