GETTING AROUND

Parking is available at Kate Granger Building (GU2 7YH) on our Manor Park campus, but we recommend travelling by public transport where possible.

When you arrive, follow signs to check-in at the Kate Granger Building, where we will scan your pre-booked e-ticket.

Campus maps can be found at the back of this guide. Yellow signs will mark the open day walking routes around our Manor Park campus. You can also visit Stag Hill campus by taking the free shuttle bus from Manor Park Reception to Stag Hill Piazza. Follow the gold flags from Kate Granger Building to Manor Park Reception.

Please let us know in advance if you have any accessibility requirements so we can make sure you get the most out of your open day. Contact: opendays@surrey.ac.uk

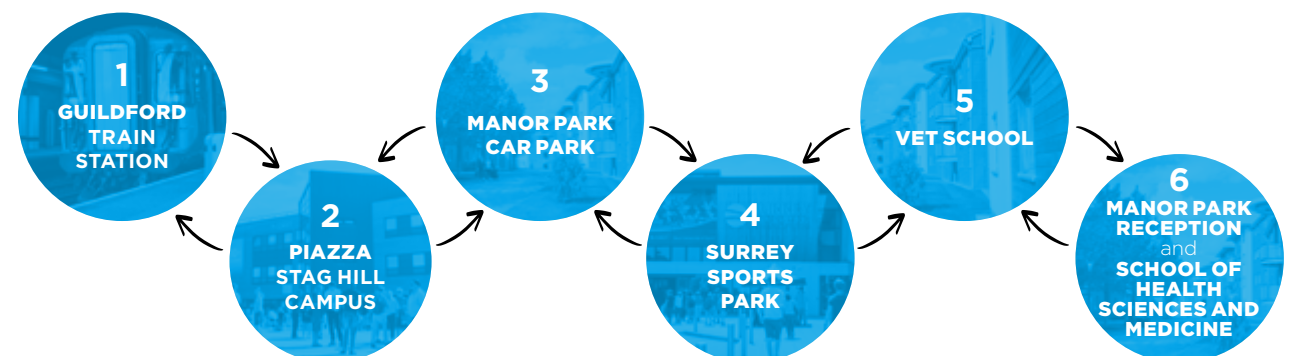
If you have any queries on the day, please visit the check-in desk in Kate Granger reception.

Talks will provide an introduction to Surrey, the campuses and life here in Guildford, followed by more information about studying nursing, midwifery, paramedic science or graduate medicine at Surrey.

You will have selected the time of your subject talk when you booked your open day place. Your open day e-ticket (sent via email) states your talk time, so please make sure you bring this with you and attend the correct talk. Your e-ticket will admit you and one guest to your booked talk(s).

Open day staff will be there to help and check your e-ticket when you arrive.

Our **Graduate Medical School Tours** will last approximately 45 minutes and will depart at: 11:15am, 11:50am, 12:50pm, 2:15pm. This tour is appropriate for Medicine prospects only.

When you arrive at check-in please visit our tour desk to collect a ticket in advance of your chosen tour. Tickets will be allocated on a first come first served basis. At busy times, tours may be limited to prospective students only.
