You will need to submit an Extended CV to the RPL/ RPC Board along with evidence of successful completion of a Level HE 5/ 6 research module (or equivalent) within the last 5 years.

- If your studies were more than 5 years ago you will need to evidence how you have kept yourself updated & developed your knowledge skills and understanding.
- If you are seeking advanced standing for MSc studies (level 7) you will need to provide evidence of having studied research at level 6.

The contents of the Extended CV will need to be mapped against the programme learning outcomes for the relevant level of study- further details may be found later in this document.

#### WHAT TO INCLUDE IN AN EXTENDED CV AND HOW TO PRESENT THE INFORMATION

**For exemption from level 4 credits** you will need to provide evidence of learning against certificate level FHEQ descriptor
